

Common Questions or situations that we want to share with you as a member:

*We are a 100% Volunteer based organization. If you feel something is not being done to your satisfaction, come and volunteer and help, make things better. Tell the executive your issues and we will see if we can resolve them for you

*Payment options are on page 3 of the membership application form.

*Please be aware we are a Fish & Game Association we are NOT a gun club!

*The use of all types of Binary Explosive Canisters, including but not limited to Tannerite, as well as all compounds that ignite or explode when struck by a projectile, are prohibited on Ponoka Fish and Game ranges as of January 19, 2017. Failure to comply will result in the revocation of membership.

*If you did not already know the calendar on our website is “live” so in order to avoid disappointment when you arrive and have the potential of a rental, please check the calendar the day before and in the morning before you head out to the range. If we have had to close it for any reason it will be noted as RENTED on the date specified

*We have 3 properties that the club manages. The main grounds along highway 2 is the only one that you are allowed to discharge firearms at. The Second Chain lakes and the Gull Lake property are first come first parked camping areas, ONLY. The maps to each of the properties are on the Web page.

*If you find an injured animal the Ponoka Fish & game club are NOT able to assist you. You need to contact your local Alberta Fish & Wildlife Office.

*If you are looking to complete the PAL course or the Restricted PAL course, please contact Leonard Davis – his number is on the “About Us” page on the Web site. He can fill you in when he is teaching it at the club house.

*When you purchase a membership with us you are then also a part of the Alberta Fish & Game Association. Please check out their Web site for information on what your membership with them gets for you.

*If you have any questions through the year, please refer to the “About Us” page on the web site to find the appropriate Chair person to bring your question forward to. Or join us at a meeting the first Thursday of each month at 1930 hours, we are always glad to see new faces around the table.

*What is the 12(6) questions for in regard to my PAL. If you look on the back of your PAL it will say non restricted, Restricted and possibly 12(6). If it does not say 12(6) you don't have that type of License, please do not circle that option. This in regard to grandfathered firearms.

*When you are providing your PAL or Firearms license number please include ALL of the number, including the 4 numbers after the decimal.
